

Here are a few updates for what's coming up:

-The creek and drain repair on #13 has been completed. The last step will be to get the seed/sod down at the proper time. The repair looks tremendous.

-The next item on the agenda through the Improvement Fund is cart path repairs. That project will continue in mid-April.

-The golf calendar is complete and online for you to view. The Tri-Fold calendars, listing all the member events for the year, should be available around the end of March for you to pick up and take home.

-The first golf event of the year is our Masters Par 3 Challenge on April 10th. -Registration for both the T&A Adventure and Ladies Match Play events opens on March 27th.

-The Opening Day golf event is April 20th so please mark your calendars!!

Our Winter Simulator Leagues have been a tremendous hit this off-season! The Club runs organized Leagues for our Senior Men and also for those that are in our regular Men's League throughout the winter. BUNKER TO BUNKER

I sure wish weather would make its mind up what it wants to do! About 2 weeks ago we had 50 degree days, then we got about 4 inches of snow, followed by 60 degree days! Shawn and Brian have been busy rebuilding and grinding reels getting ready for this upcoming season. We did acquire newer John Deere triplex mowers during this off season to replace our Jacobsen greens mowers. The Jacobsen mowers did a great job on greens, but did tear up the turf when mower had to make sharp turns on greens such as left and right side of #1 green. Due to an offset wheel alignment, the John Deere does not tear up so that is why we went back to the John Deeres.



With the weather jumping around the way it is, it has created some chaos with the turf. One moment the turf is resting comfortably, using its energy to create better roots, then temperatures go up and the energy is moved from roots to trying to grow leaf tissue. This is not really what I would like to see as the plants need the rest time typically from December thru February. This winter has seen a large fluctuation in temperatures that has made it difficult for the plants to rest. I do not foresee any major issues with this so far it is just that I would like for the plants to grow as much roots as possible to help the plants thru the season.

Shawn was out on the brush cutter on our Bobcat cutting up a lot of the brush growing in natural areas and in the tree lines where he could get. The project on #13 looks great and has really changed that area. We have had a couple rainfalls that have tested the pipe and creek and everything is working as it should.

With these crazy temperatures we have been able to open the greens from time to time and allow carts out. It looks like the forecast shows we might start mowing sooner than later,

which means golfing season is that much closer! Look forward to seeing you all out on the course soon! Paul L Double



The joint project on #13 between Sugar Valley Golf Club and SVGC Capitol Fund Committee is coming along great. Diamond Excavating has installed and backfilled the pipe and shaped the new area for fairway and rough. The purpose of this project was to replace the corroded galvanized tile that once went under #13 fairway. The tile was causing erosion and was becoming a safety risk.

They reshaped the creek going all the way to the outlet part of the pipe on #14. They placed rock along the creek and reshaped the washout area at the pipe in #14. They used some of the extra dirt to fill in the low area down in the area to help reduce ponding after heavy rains.





Once the area can dry enough, we will get in there and do a finish grade on the area and prep area for sod and seed. The fairway will be approximately 15-20' wider in this area. We had the old cherry tree that was dying removed and it has really opened up the area.

Until further notice, #13 green is closed and we ask all golfers to only play to the temporary flag in the fairway. We do not want people walking thru this area as we will be finishing it soon and ground is uneven and somebody could trip. A couple weeks ago, we had a few people that decided to play to the green and walked thru the construction area. When we seed and sod, it will be critical people stay out of this area.


Fun Irish Food Facts!
